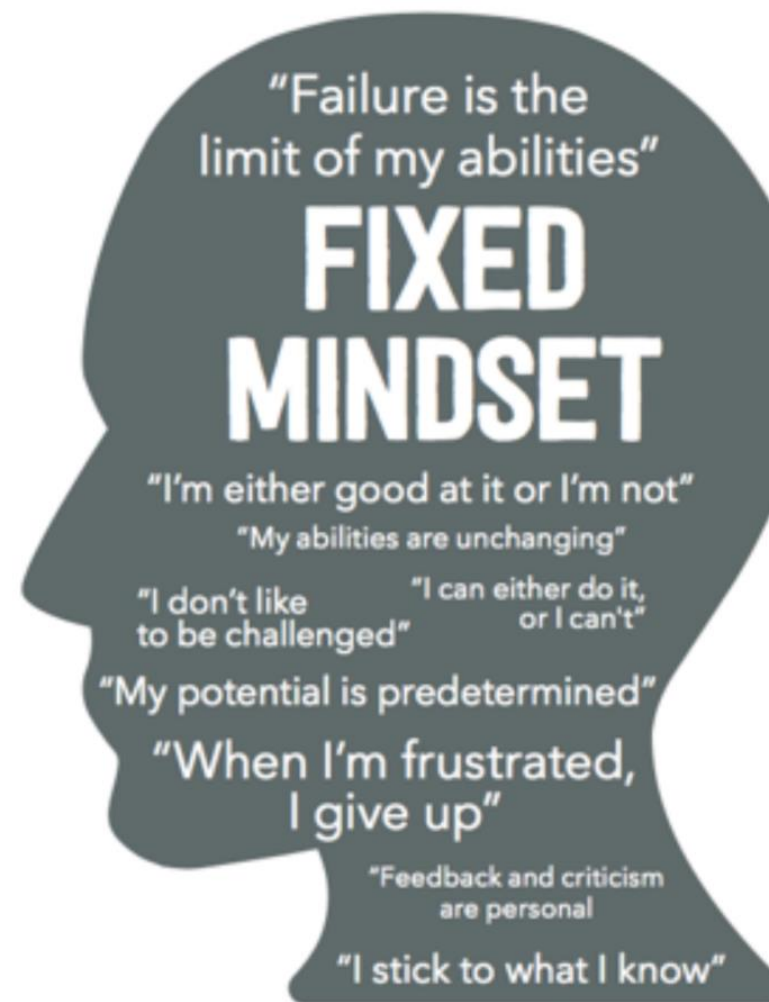
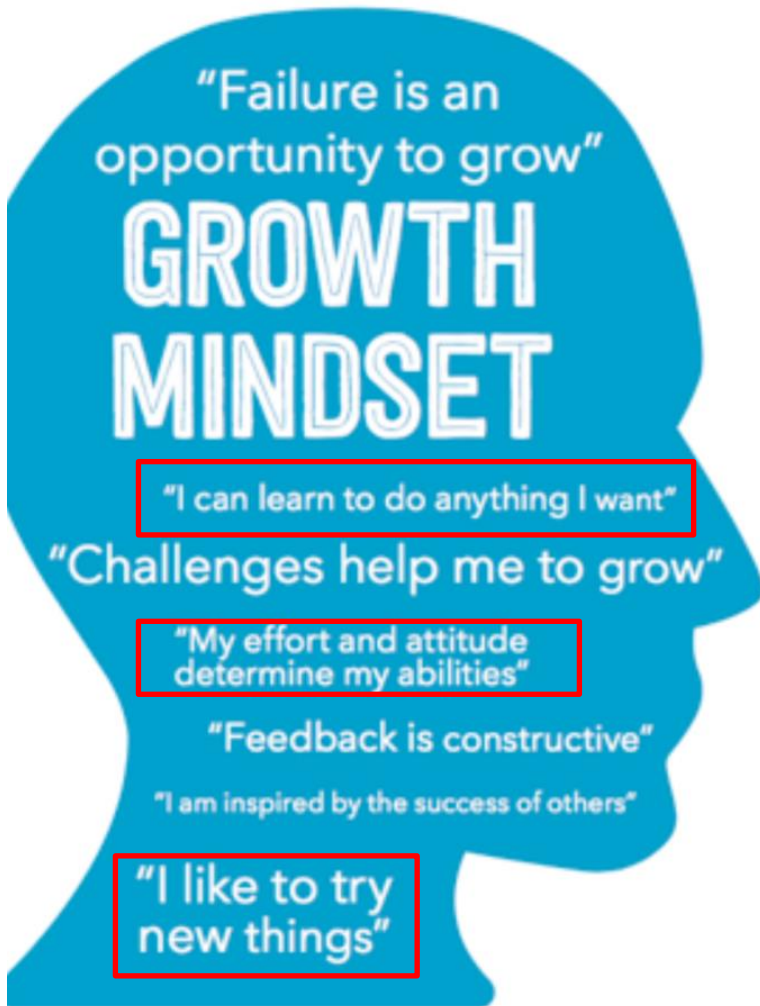
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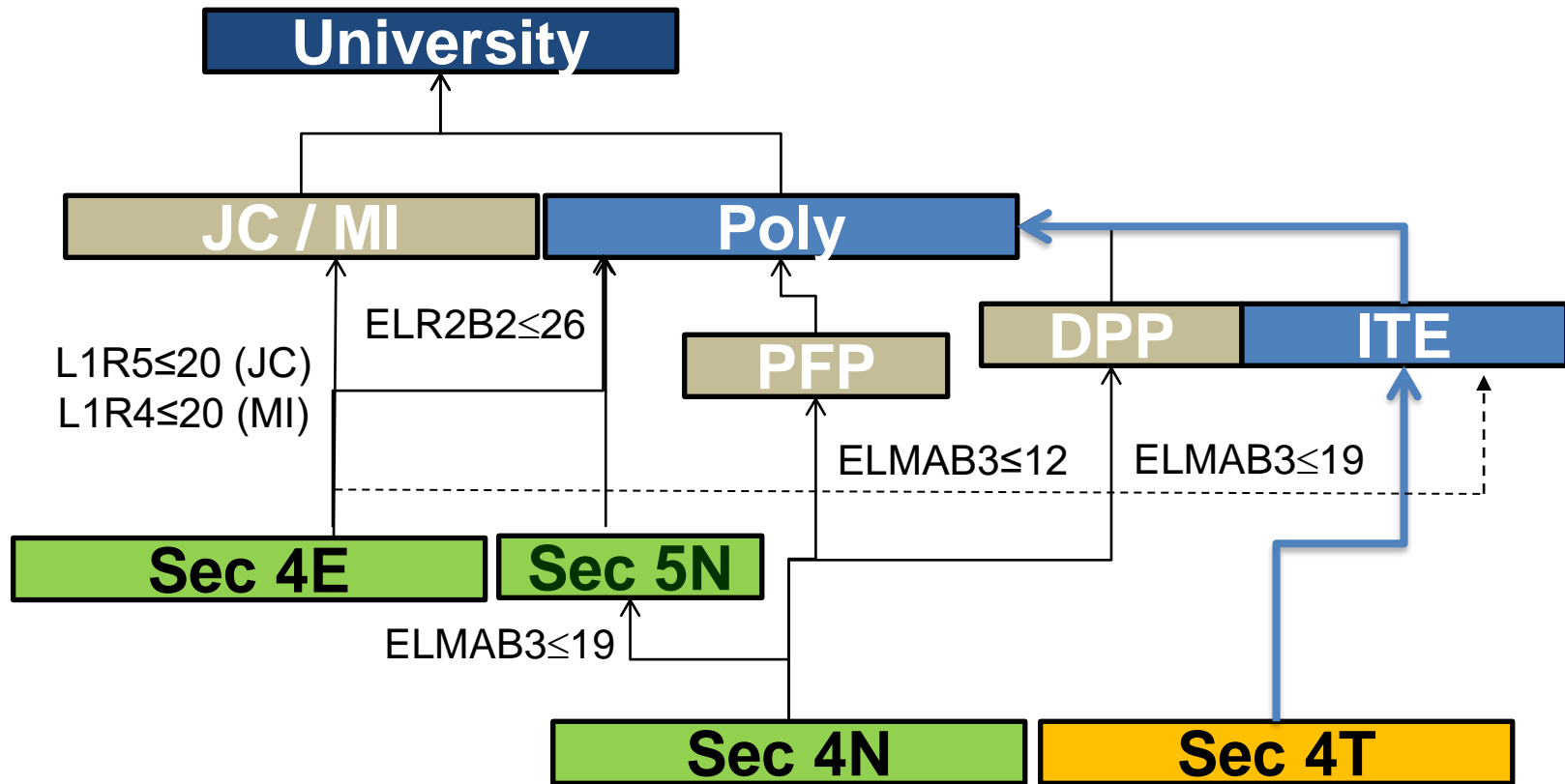
# Criteria for Promotion to Sec 3 NT

		Criteria
Sec 2 Normal (Technical)	Transferred to 2 Normal (Academic)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Met minimum attainment level <u>and</u></li><li>• Minimum of 70% in the overall percentage of all subjects combined</li></ul>
	Promoted to 3 Normal (Technical)	At least Grade 5 or better in <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 2 subjects, one of which should be English or Mathematics</li></ul>
	Retained at 2 Normal (Technical)	Has not met minimum attainment level Note: Below maximum age

- Sec 4 N(T) students have the following progression opportunities:

- To be **eligible**, students must **satisfy the minimum entry requirements of the specific course**.
- A **strong foundation in literacy, numeracy and reasoning** would ensure students are **better prepared** for these progression pathways.
- **Therefore, students are encouraged to deepen their knowledge in English, Mathematics and Science.**

# Posting to Nitec Courses

- Posting is based on **merit** and **subject to vacancies** in open competition.
  - Based on aggregate of the best 4 GCE 'N' Level subjects, including pre-requisite subjects and bonus points (where applicable); and
  - Met **course-specific entry requirements**.
- Many *Nitec* courses require a pass in subjects such as **English**, **Mathematics** and **Science** – good foundation in these subjects is **critical** to students performing well in the corresponding *Nitec* courses.
- Doing well in these subjects in secondary school, especially at the higher level, will **position students better to perform well in ITE**.

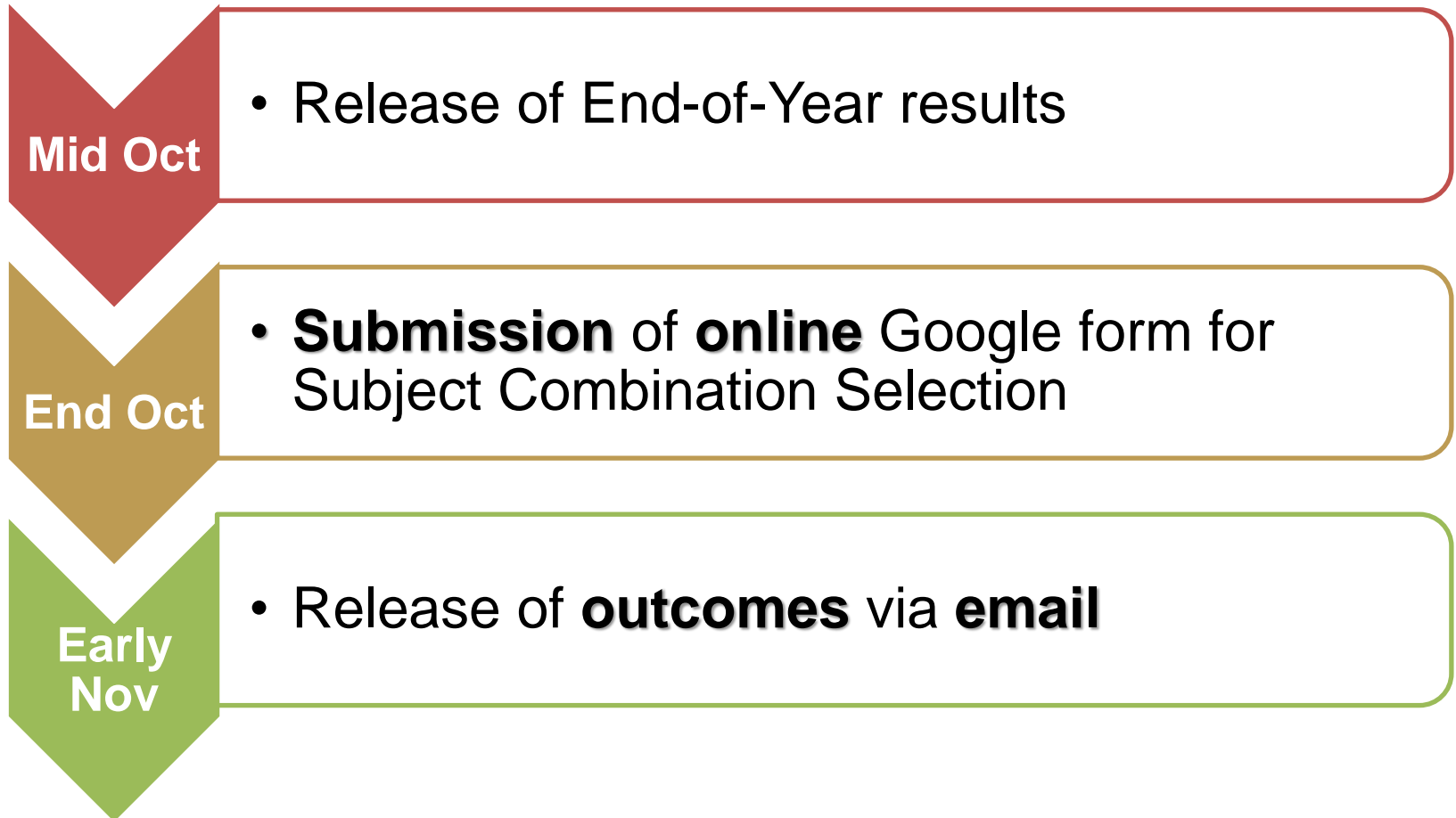

Mathematics (NA)	Overall $\geq 60\%$ and MA $\geq 60\%$
Science (NA)	Overall $\geq 60\%$ and SC $\geq 60\%$

## For Normal (Technical) Students (non-SBB)

Subject	Criteria
English (NT)	Overall $\geq 60\%$ and EL $\geq 85\%$
Mother Tongue (NT)	Overall $\geq 60\%$ and MT $\geq 85\%$
Mathematics (NT)	Overall $\geq 60\%$ and MA $\geq 85\%$
Science (NT)	Overall $\geq 60\%$ and SC $\geq 85\%$
