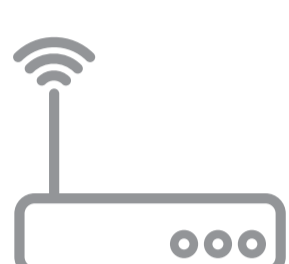

With Home Access 3.0

Low-income households can apply to receive 2 years of subsidised internet access, increased broadband speed at 500Mbps or 1Gbps. Low-income households without school-going children have the option to own a smartphone or tablet

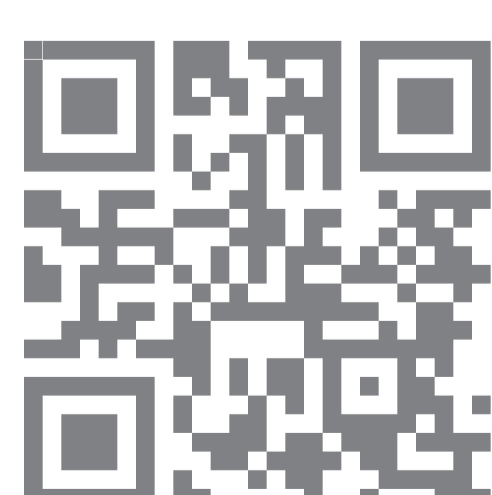
